Dear Parents/Carers

As part of the History GCSE course, students study the rise of the Nazi party in Germany during the 1930s. This section of the course constitutes 30% of the final grade and is assessed during an 80 minute exam in June.

To help prepare the students for this, the History Department would like to invite your child on a trip that combines drama with specific exam advice - **Hitler on Trial**. This is a half-day presentation designed to help students focus on the German element of their GCSE exam. Hitler on Trial starts with a 'grade-boosting' workshop, followed by a courtroom drama, where students are drawn into a world where Hitler is placed on trial in 1942. Written by eminent historians and acted by a professional cast, this trip is an greatly encouraged for students studying Nazi Germany.

The cost of the trip is £45.00 and as places are limited, they will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. The trip will be closed as soon as all places have been taken so you are encouraged to secure a place via ParentPay as soon as possible to avoid disappointment for your child. The cut off date has been extended to Monday 9th September.
