Y10 GCSE 3D Design Trip – Design Museum/Battersea Power Station Wednesday27th November 2024

****LIMITED PLACES: 40 places available on a first come, first served basis via ParentPay****

The Design Department will be taking Year 10 GCSE 3D Design students on a trip to the 'Design Museum' and Battersea Power Station on Wednesday 27th November 2024. This is an excellent opportunity for students to experience the history of furniture design and the Tim Burton exhibition which will feed into their Bauhaus coursework project. We will then visit Battersea Power station to photograph the station architecture and surrounding buildings which will feed directly into their 'An Engine for Living' architecture project later in the year.

We will be leaving school at 8.30am and will travel by coach to the design Museum. All students will be required to wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch, camera, pencil, drawing pen or black biro, rubber, and if desired, some spending money for the gift shops. I anticipate we will return to school for approximately 3.30-4pm.

The cost of the trip is £30.00 and as places are limited, they will be allocated on a first-come, firstserved basis. Should there not be enough interest, the trip may not be viable - in that case all monies paid would be refunded and this decision will be taken on 18 October 2024.

The trip will be closed as soon as all places have been taken so you are encouraged to secure a place via ParentPay as soon as possible to avoid disappointment for your child.

Please make payment via ParentPay and complete the emergency contact and medical details sections on your ParentPay account. You are also asked if you agree to your child being photographed/recorded which may be used on social media.

Your commitment for your child to attend is non-refundable, regardless of reason (unless covered by insurance) or unless a replacement student can be found for them which we would endeavour to do. This is because non-refundable tickets will be purchased specifically and travel and trip associated costs will be spread across the expected cohort.
