End of Half Term 2 and Start of Half Term 3 Arrangements

I am writing to notify you of the arrangements for the end of Half Term 2 and the start of Half Term 3.

Period 5 lessons for Year 11 and Sixth Form students will recommence from Tuesday 7 January 2025.
