**Re: Sixth Form Theatre Trip – Hamilton – Mayflower Theatre, Southampton
Thursday 27th March 2025**

We have an unmissable opportunity to attend a performance of Hamilton at the Mayflower Theatre, Southampton on Thursday 27th March 2025.

Hamilton narrates Alexander Hamilton's life in two acts, and details, among other things, his involvement in the American Revolutionary War as a aide-de-camp to George Washington, his marriage to Eliza Schuyler Hamilton, his career as a lawyer and Secretary of the Treasury and his interactions with Aaron Burr which culminates in their duel at the end of Hamilton's life.

Students will be leaving school by coach at 12pm and returning at approximately 6.30pm. Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them, and they may also wish to bring some extra money for souvenirs – please note most theatres operate a cashless system.

The cost of the trip is £44.00 and as places are limited, they will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

The trip will be closed as soon as all places have been taken – or on Monday 3rd February so we can confirm actual ticket numbers with the venue. Therefore, you are encouraged to secure a place via ParentPay as soon as possible to avoid disappointment for your child. We will then open up a reserve list.

Please make payment via ParentPay and complete the emergency contact and medical details sections on your ParentPay account. You are also asked if you agree to your child being photographed/recorded which may be used on social media.

Your commitment for your child to attend is non-refundable, regardless of reason (unless covered by insurance) or unless a replacement student can be found for them which we would endeavour to do. This is because non-refundable tickets will be purchased specifically and travel and associated trip costs will be spread across the expected cohort.
